**Caterpillars and Butterflies** We have had a frighteningly fabulous first week back, celebrating Halloween together. The children have been looking at rhyming words to make potent potions, creating Halloween pictures and even carving their own pumpkins! What a great way to kick off our new topic: Celebrations.



**Class 1** We have had a very busy week having our individual photographs taken, flu vaccinations and reading with our parents. Thank you to the parents who joined us. We introduced our new class reading book – Dogger and have had great fun reading this book together as a class. We have practised spelling some tricky words and are really trying our best with these! We have looked at celebrating festivals, making clay pumpkins, junk model fireworks, night sky firework pictures and learning poems about Halloween and Bonfire night, which we used in our writing. In Maths we have looked at 2D and 3D shapes, ask your children to name the shapes we have been looking at, they have done a fantastic job! Well done Class 1, keep up the good work! @Allanolane

**Class 2** What a great week. We have had 100% for 4/5 days and only 1 away today. We have been learning all about Halloween and bonfire night. **Class 3** We have had a great first week back after the half term break. In Maths, we have been looking at column subtraction and the borrowing of numbers from other columns. In our writing, we are looking at informal letters and have been identifying informal language from examples and looking at the structure of a letter before we have a go at writing our own. We are starting to look at Anglo-Saxons in Topic and I can tell the children are already excited to learn more about them in the coming weeks. Please ensure that PE kit is in school on Mondays and Thursdays and that your child is reading 5 times a week so they can come in non-uniform on a Friday.

**Class 4** Year 4 have settled back in really this week and produced some excellent work. In maths we have been carrying on with addition and subtraction and in literacy we have been writing persuasive letters. In our topic work we have started to learn about the Anglo Saxons. Remember to read five times this week so you can wear your own clothes next Friday!

**Class 5** This week in maths we have been looking at numbers in the tens of thousands. We have been working on our times tables and are trying to be quicker at multiplication problems. For literacy we have been writing informal letters all about ourselves to Miss Peart. We have also been revisiting the rules for plurals in our spellings and doing lots of listening comprehensions. We are getting much better at listening!

**Class 6** Class 6 have been writing explanations this week. Do you know why monsters hide under the bed? We have tried to explain why using casual conjunctions. We have also enjoyed copying rhythms in music (see photo). In maths we have begun a topic on fractions. Our topic this half term is Anglo Saxons.
