**Caterpillars and Butterflies** We have all had a large focus on number this week, thinking about what numbers actually mean and counting out various amounts. Nursery will be consolidating their knowledge of numbers to 5 next week and Reception will be continuing to think about the concept of 'more' and 'less'. The children have all been working extremely hard and I am sure they will continue to keep it up!

**Class 1** In Literacy we have been looking at the story of Rumpelstiltskin this week, ask your children to tell you the story and use their goblin voices! In maths we have been learning to use number lines to help us count the jumps forwards and backwards, we even did this ourselves on a large scale in P.E. We talked about how we celebrated Bonfire night and how we kept ourselves safe. @Allanolane

**Class 2** This week we have been learning all about using scales to measure mass. The children have been finding more than and less than different objects. We have also been reading fairytale books to innovate and make our own. We have not had 100% at all this week. Please can you all put the extra effort in and try to come to school every day! **Class 3** This week we have been working hard on arrays and repeated addition to help us answer multiplication problems. In Literacy, we have been writing informal letters and making sure we use paragraphs in our work. PE is every Monday and Thursday so make sure you have kit in school for those days and make sure you're reading 5 times a week so you can come in non-uniform on Friday! To avoid confusion, it would be helpful if the date was also written in reading records when you have read. Thank you.



**Class 4** It's been another good week for year 4 with lots going on. In maths we have been using our times tables to learn multiplication and division facts and in literacy we have been continuing with our persuasive writing. On Wednesday we designed some excellent Christmas cards for a competition to send to Yvette Cooper! Homework is due back on Monday and remember to read 5 times to be able to come in your own clothes next Friday.

**Class 5** We have been writing character descriptions. We have been using lots of adjectives, adverbs, similes and metaphors. Also we have learnt about the contractive apostrophe. In maths, we have been looking at factors and prime numbers. Spellings and one other piece of homework will be sent home every Friday or Monday to be learned or handed in for the following Friday. We aim to get at least 7/10 in our spellings.

**Class 6** We have continued to develop their confidence and expertise with fractions this week; we have compared and ordered fractions including improper fractions and mixed numbers.
