**Class 2** This week Class 2 have been learning about place value and how to add tens and ones together. We have innovated George Saves The Day by Lunch to create some great new stories! **Class 3** This week Class 3 have been looking at how to find 100 more or less than a number and how to order and compare numbers up to 1000. We have also been locating where Italy and the UK are on a map of Europe so we can see how far and why the Romans travelled to Britain. PE is every Monday and Thursday so please ensure PE kit is in school for these days. Remember to read 5 times a week so you can come in non-uniform each Friday.

**Class 4** We have had a great week of learning. The effort from the class has been brilliant and everyone has been putting 100% into their work. In maths, we have been working with negative numbers and linking them to temperature. In literacy, we have been writing character descriptions and putting together some effective descriptive phrases.

Homework will be due in on Monday and remember to keep practicing your spellings!

**Class 5** Fabulous week in year 5! We are all loving trying to fit our word of the day into our writing from vocabulary ninja. Ask your child about our words – can they tell you what plethora means? We have also enjoyed learning about negative numbers this week. We have practised column methods of addition subtraction and multiplication through problem solving and our setting descriptions have been improved by borrowing ideas from published authors.
