Class 2 This week we have been learning how to save the world. We have created instructions for our superheroes to follow. We have also been learning about addition and subtraction. Class 3 This week Class 3 have been looking at character descriptions and in particular, looking at Mr. Willy Wonka from Charlie and The Chocolate Factory. We have enjoyed looking at how well Roald Dahl described this eccentric individual and we hope to be able to describe our own characters next week! In Maths, we have been looking at how to add 1 digit numbers to 3 digit numbers and in Topic, we have been working out the chronology of Roman rule in Britain and describing Boudicca. Remember that PE is every Monday and Thursday so PE kit should be in school on these days and make sure to read 5 times so you can come to school in non-uniform each Friday.



Class 4 We have had another great week and have been working really hard. We have used our descriptive writing skills to create some brilliant story settings in literacy and have been rounding numbers to the nearest hundred in maths. Remember to read five times to come in your own clothes next Friday!

Class 5 In year 5 we are learning our 6 times table. Make sure your child is practising every day as we are working hard in class using Numeracy Ninja practice papers every morning. In writing we have been looking at using interesting expanded noun phrases to improve our writing in our character descriptions from the book Clockwork. PE days in year 5 are on Tuesdays and Thursdays so ensure your child has kit in school on these days. Please make sure your child has a water bottle in school so that they can access water from our fountain in the shared area.

Class 6 Another great week in Class 6! We have really enjoyed putting actions into our character descriptions through talk, focused on dialogue and interesting vocabulary. In maths we have looked at division but are struggling because we do not know our x-tables well enough. Please help us practice the multiplication and related division facts at home.
